Information for the Parents (VI-VIII BS & GS)

Dear Parents,

At this critical stage of social distancing and complete lockdown of regular schooling, we want to ensure that each of our students continue to have access to quality curriculum and assignments to bridge the learning gaps created due to this global crisis of COVID-19.. We plan to deliver instruction through a virtual learning environment and we need your support to ensure the success of our efforts. Please take a moment to review our plan below and talk with your child about the importance of continuing their education during this intervening period.

Please remind the child that working hard on an exercise is essential and a normal part of the learning process. When evaluating the knowledge acquired through remote learning, have it in mind that it is not how quickly things are done that matters, but whether the content is understood, memorized and can be used in the future.

Modus Operandi:

- Students will receive instruction through pre-recorded videos, PPTs, Links to YouTube videos, PDF files of textual matter, notes, worksheets, assignments, tests etc shared through Whatsapp class groups and to be uploaded on our website in core subjects viz English, Math, Science, and Social Studies, Hindi & Third Language and auxiliary subjects such as Computer Science, Islamic Studies/Moral science, Compulsory Arabic, SAC.
- Classes for all core subjects for Classes VI - VIII will also be conducted online through Zoom app which must be downloaded preferably on your desktop or laptop or on smart phone. Students will log into the Zoom class with their names as registered with the school.
- Students should login on the Class groups (under your supervision) each day to check for lessons, assignments and instructions from the teacher.
- Beginning Tuesday, April 7th, 2020 instructional videos for core & auxiliary subjects will be uploaded.
- Teachers will post relevant e-lesson & TLM to support students with instructional delivery of content such as annotated notes, PowerPoint presentations and website links.
- Teachers will be available to monitor and respond to student queries from 9:30 am until 12:30 PM every day regarding questions about lessons, assignments and instructional material.
- Class teachers will conduct a Zoom meeting once a week for more guidance and feedback.

Role of Parents:

- Ensure that your child checks the posts on daily basis.
- Ensure that your child watches the recorded videos.
- Ensure that your child is completing all required assignments in a timely manner and completes the notebook regularly.
- Encourage your child to reach out to their teacher if they have any questions or concerns or need any extra help.
- Do not post personal queries on group.
- Interact with teachers only between 9:30 AM to 12:30pm as beyond these time-frames, they will be working on building the resources. However, in case of any prominent query, teachers may be consulted beyond prescribed time.

Expecting your wholehearted cooperation to make this e- mission a success.

Tips for Online Learning for Students

To get the most out of distance learning, Class teachers will brief students on the following points:;

Time Management: Keep a track of online classes. Prepare a study Timetable for offline studies.

Participation: Attend online sessions. Try to ask questions and complete tasks on time.

Environment: Environment can have a huge impact on how much information you absorb. If you need complete quiet, find a quiet space. Minimize distractions. Make sure that you:

- Sit in a supportive chair
- Have enough space for notebooks and papers
- Have a good source of light and ventilation
- Keep away from constant interruptions
- Make hard copies of all your online notes and assignments
- Make subject wise folder on your computer to save all lessons, worksheets, assignments
- Use earphones if possible (recommended for clarity and helps in concentrating)
- Complete your work/ notebook regularly
- Always be online under parental supervision while using your mobile or laptop.
