- There will be two terms: Term I from April to September. Term II from October to March.

- Syllabus coverage in Term II Syllabus covered in Term II and important concepts taught in the First Term to be repeated (specified in the break-up of syllabus) up to a maximum of 10% of the First Term portion for all the classes.
- Subject Enrichment Activities which will be subject-specific, aiming at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students, will be carried out and assessed throughout the term.
- Marks are also allotted for completion and maintenance of notebooks.
