Subject: Assessment Plan-2019-20 - III-V Block

With curriculum designing going through dynamic changes and demands in society progressing in leaps and bounds, the need of the hour is to lay a strong foundation for the students at school. IISJ endeavours to fulfil this by focusing on laying a strong foundation at the primary level. In order to prepare our students at the primary level for the challenges ahead and with the objective to provide both a formal and informal academic ambience, changes have been made in the assessment of the students of classes III-V.

The following assessment plan will be followed by Classes III-V from the academic session 2019 - 2020:

- There will be two terms: Term I from April to September. Term II from October to March.
- There will be one Periodic Assessment and the Term End Exam in each term.
- English, Math, EVS, Hindi and Third languages will be tested in the Periodic Assessment and Term Exam.
- Computer Science, Islamic Studies/Moral Science, Compulsory Arabic and Art & Craft will be tested only in the Term End Exam.
- Syllabus coverage in Term I - Syllabus covered as per the break-up of syllabus.
- Syllabus coverage in Term II - Syllabus covered in Term II and important concepts taught in the First Term to be repeated (specified in the break-up of syllabus) up to a maximum of 10% of the First Term portion for all the classes.
- Subject Enrichment Activities which will be subject-specific, aiming at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students, will be carried out and assessed throughout the term.
- Marks are also allotted for completion and maintenance of notebooks.
