CIRCULAR

Sub: Instructions to students/parents regarding Class X Registration Form & Two Levels of Mathematics for Term I Board Examination in Nov/Dec 2021 and Term II Board Examination in March/April 2022

1. Student and one parent (Father or mother or guardian) to visit the School (girls in Girls' Section and boys in Boys' Section) on the specified date and time as informed by the Class Teacher.
2. In view of the pandemic, thermal screening at the entrance, wearing of masks, and maintaining social distancing is mandatory.
3. Items required to be brought:
 - (i) 2 passport size photographs (in School uniform on white back ground with name, class & section written on the back side)
 - (ii) Board Examination original fee Receipt: SAR 575/- + VAT 15 %
 - (iii) Copy of Class IX Report
4. Take the printed Form from the Class Teacher and verify all the details printed on it carefully. Both the student and parent will sign the Form, attach the documents mentioned in point no.3 above and submit it to the Class Teacher.
5. Parents are advised to pay the fee well in advance to avoid inconvenience at the time of submission of forms.
6. Corrections in the entries are permitted with proof.
7. There is no proof required in case of correction in Annual income in INR.
8. If Aadhar Card is there, then mention the Aadhar Number but it is not mandatory.
9. **TWO LEVELS OF MATHEMATICS:** The two levels are designated as Mathematics Basic (Subject Code: 241) and Mathematics Standard (Subject Code: 041). Basic is easy level meant for students not keen to pursue Mathematics at higher Class after Class X. Standard is meant for students who wish to opt for Mathematics at Senior Secondary (XI & XII) after Class X. Please note that for both levels of Examination the class room instruction is same. Also be informed that once the Level gets registered with CBSE, later it cannot be changed. **Parents are advised to go through the FAQs given on back side of this circular before opting the Level in the Exam Form for Class X Term I Board Examination –Nov/Dec 2021 & Term II Board Examination- March/April 2022.**
10. **Correction (change) in the Level of Mathematics printed on the Form is allowed and after this correction, it cannot be changed.**

FAQs on Two Levels of Mathematics:

- Q.1.** What is the difference between the Standard Level and Basic Level of Mathematics in class - X Board examinations?
Ans: Standard-Level and Basic-level Question papers shall be based on the same syllabus. However the Standard-Level Mathematics assesses higher Mathematical abilities compared to Basic-Level. Accordingly, the difficulty level of the Mathematics – 'Basic' is less than that of Mathematics- 'Standard'.
- Q.2.** Are we increasing the burden on the child by introducing the concept of two Levels of Exams in Mathematics?
Ans: No, because the option to pick either Level is with the student. Further, the syllabus prescribed by CBSE will remain the same for both the levels.
- Q.3.** Will this lead to dilution of Mathematics syllabus/teaching?
Ans: No, the idea is to make the evaluation more students centric and reduce the pressure on the student who doesn't want to pursue Mathematics after class X.
- Q.4.** Can a student opt for both Standard Level and Basic Level Exams?
Ans: No. There is only one option, either Mathematics-Standard or Mathematics-Basic.
- Q.5.** To continue Mathematics as a subject in class XI/XII and further, which Level Exam does a student need to pass?
Ans: Mathematics-Standard is to be passed at class X, for taking up Mathematics at Sr. Secondary level.
- Q.6.** If a student qualifies only the Mathematics-Basics in class X, can he/she opt for Mathematics in class XI/XII?
Ans: No. If he/she intends to take Mathematics in class XI/XII, he/she has to pass Mathematics-Standard.
- Q.7.** If a student has registered for the Basic Level Exam but wishes to appear for the Standard Level after declaration of Final Result, can he/she do so?
Ans: Yes. He/She can appear in the Standard Level at the Compartment examination, if he/she wishes to do so after passing the Basic Mathematics Examination.
- Q.8.** Can a student opt for Mathematics-Basic for Term I Board Exam & Mathematics-Standard for Term II Board Exam and vice versa ?
Ans: No. For both the Board Exams, the Level opted must be same.
- Q.9.** If a student qualifies Class X with Mathematics-Basic, can he/she opt for Science Stream in Class XI / XII?
Ans: Yes. He / She is eligible to opt for Science Stream(XI/XII) but cannot opt the subject Mathematics.
