You are aware that for 2021-22 Academic Session, CBSE is conducting Class X & XII Board Exams (Theory & Practical) in two terms. The First Term Board Examination is scheduled to be held in PHYSICAL MODE during Nov/Dec 2021. The Date Sheet is going to be released by CBSE very soon.

Since these exams are going to be held in the School Premises in Physical Mode, parents of those students who are stuck up in India are herewith advised to make arrangements accordingly so that their wards enter the Kingdom before 1st Nov 2021 in order to appear in the First Term Board Examinations in Physical Mode.

Parents of those students who cannot make such arrangement due to various reasons/restrictions are herewith advised to make a request to the School for Change of Centre immediately. The request should contain the following details:

- 1.Name of the Student
- 2.GR No.
- 3.Class & Section
- 4.Complete Address in India with Name of the District & State
- 5.Contact No.(India) & Contact No. in KSA.
6. Email ID(it should be active)

The requests may be submitted to the concerned HMs on or before 11th Oct 2021.

It is to be noted that CBSE has not issued any guidelines regarding change of centre. The School has written to CBSE requesting the Board to issue guidelines.

If no guidelines for change of centre are issued from CBSE, then such students will be at risk of losing one academic year because students must appear for Term I(Nov/Dec 2021) & Term II (March/April 2022) Board Exams in order to get the Final Result.
