Periodic Assessment-I for the students of VI-VIII block will be conducted through virtual mode in compliance to the circular No. IISJ/PR/2020-21/14, dated June 05, 2020, as per the date-sheet given below:

- Timing for the test will be from 9:00 am to 10:30 am (1 ½ hour duration for each paper).
- Maximum marks for each subject will be 40 (40 Marks).
- Type of Questions: - For English, Math, Science & Social Sciences - Questions asked will be multiple choice, fill in the blanks, True or False, very short and short answers .
- Hindi and 3rd language papers will have only multiple choice questions (MCQ) type questions.
- The link for the test will be sent on the registered email just before the test.
- Kindly confirm your wards email id with the class teacher on or before June 15, 2020.
- A mock test will be conducted 3 days prior to the actual test to help the students get an idea of the online test format.
- Any device that supports login of email id viz. laptop/desktop/mobile phone can be used to appear for the test.
- Please ensure that your ward completes the exam before he exits the given link, as it can be attempted only once.
- Also ensure that the test is attempted within the allotted time. The child may not be able to access it after the time is elapsed.
- You may assist the child technically in operating the device but let him/her attempt the test independently to make it more meaningful and effective.
- All Entries in the Exam Paper must be done / typed in the Upper Case i.e. using only Capital Letters.
- Make sure you have a stable internet connection in order to appear for the online test.
- If at all, you face any technical glitch, during the test inform the class teacher immediately.
- Detailed instructions on how to appear for the test will be posted in the class groups prior to the mock test.
