

Dear Parents,

As per the directives from CBSE regarding the new assessment pattern which will be implemented for the Academic Year-2024-25, you are hereby informed that the Assessment schedule for UKG is revised from Three Assessments to Two Assessments.

For both LKG and UKG assessments during class activities are a continuous process, where the child will be informally assessed on different competencies as per the National Curriculum Framework for foundational stage.

An orientation in this regard is scheduled on Thursday, September 19, 2024 in Boys' School Auditorium from 07.00 PM to 08.00 PM. Parents are requested to attend the session.

An overview of the format for the report card is shared for your perusal.

Note: Competencies may differ for LKG and UKG as per the syllabus.

Physical Development

- 1. Curriculum Goal Children develop habits that keep them healthy and safe
 - Shows a liking for and understanding of nutritious food and does not waste food
 - Practices basic self-care and hygiene
 - Shows awareness of safety in movements (walking, running, cycling) and acts appropriately.
- 2. Curriculum Goal Children develop sharpness in sensorial perceptions
 - Develops visual memory for symbols and representations
 - Differentiates multiple smells and tastes
 - Develops discrimination in the sense of touch.
- Curriculum Goal Children develop a fit and flexible body

 - Shows strength and endurance in carrying, walking and running.

Socio-emotional and Ethical Development
