Subject: Update on Recent Power Outage Affecting Grades III to V-GS - September 2024

## Dear Parents,

We would like to update you on the recent power outage affecting our Girls' Section Building. This month, the school experienced a power interruption that impacted the regular class schedule for Grades III to V, requiring us to switch to online classes. We understand the effect this has had on your children's education and would like to provide you with an overview of the situation and the measures being taken to address it.

The power outage for two days in September 2024, was promptly reported to the Saudi Electric Co. (SEC). Based on an inspection and Power Audit Report by an SEC-approved consultant during the summer vacation, SEC recommended either installing an additional revenue meter breaker or upgrading the current system to handle peak summer power demands and ensure stability.

As of September 10, 2024, SEC has replaced four breakers, and we anticipate that the remaining work will be completed shortly.

The decision to shift academic activities for Grades III to V-GS to an online mode was made as a precautionary measure. The School Managing Committee (SMC) and the school are closely monitoring the situation and are in constant touch with SEC to expedite a resolution, with the goal of returning to physical and in-person classes as soon as possible.

Thank you for your understanding and patience as we work to resolve these issues.
